S1 English 2020 - 2021

Materials

For each English lesson, pupils will need:

- A soft A4 ringbinder, any colour
- Some clear plastic pockets
- A4 lined paper
- A pencil case with the usual contents:

A four-colour (red, blue, green and black) ballpoint pen;

A pencil, a pencil sharpener and an eraser;

White-out correction tape (no Tippex bottles or pens due to risk of spillages);

A small ruler;

Some highlighter pens;

A glue stick and a pair of scissors.

Pupils need not bring the entire reading list with them on their first day at school in September!

Book List






